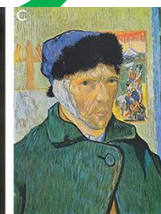


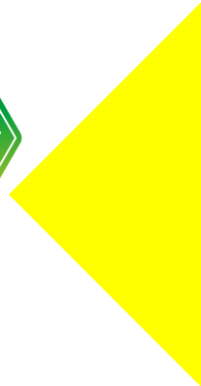
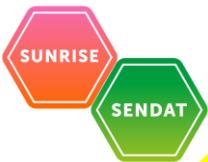
My Artist Study

Artist Name: Jackson Pollock

Jackson Pollock was an influential American painter and a major figure in the abstract expressionist movement. He was well known for his uniquely defined style of drip painting. He was regarded as a mostly reclusive artist.
