Chalk Hill Residential Statement of Purpose Student




What is Residential

Chalk Hill provides a Residential provision that is available from Monday to Friday morning. This is split into two services known as residential and Link. Our Residential service, which is the main service we offer, provides after school and overnight care, learning and activities for up to 12 students per night. Our Link provision which runs alongside Residential up to 19.00 each evening when our Link students are collected by parents and return home rather than staying overnight in Residential. Link helps students get used to staying in residence overnight and for those who are unable to come to residence due to complexities.
